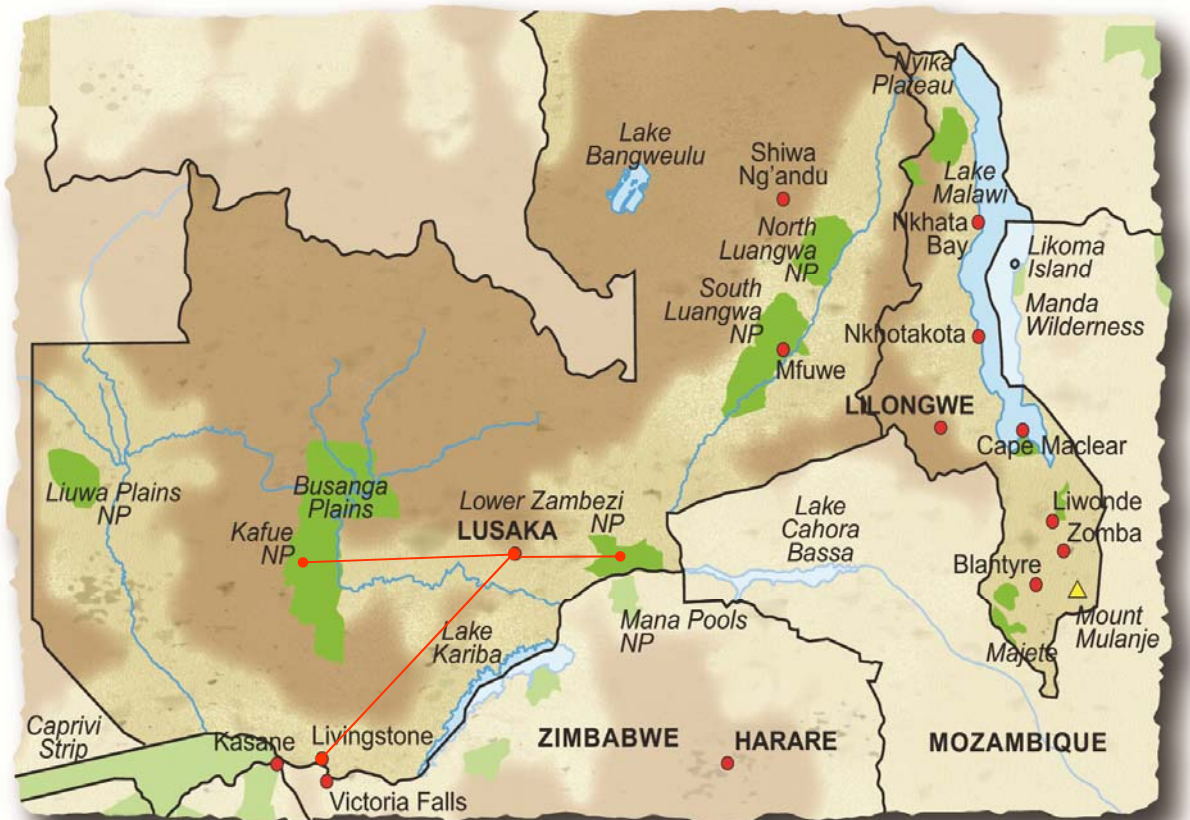


## Exclusively Zambia

## Day 1

Today you will take the international flight to Livingstone, Zambia.

## Day 2

On arrival in Livingstone you will be met and transferred to stay at Waterberry Lodge for the next 3 nights.

Livingstone is mostly visited for the incredible Victoria Falls, one of the natural wonders of the world, but also has a huge range of activities on offer from micro-lighting across the Falls to swimming above the Falls, bungee jumping and white water rafting. The famous Flight of the Angels over the Falls in a small plane is a firm favourite, and for romantics you can have a champagne breakfast on Livingstone Island which is literally in the middle of the Falls. The area offers plenty of other gentler activities, including exploring the area on foot, horseback or on game drives through the Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park.



Waterberry Lodge is a lovely lodge set on the beautiful Zambezi River. Secluded and with pretty gardens and wonderful views of the river, it is a great place to just relax on the sun deck, in the upstairs viewing lounge or around the pool, enjoying the odd sunset cruise, fishing trip or trip to Livingstone for some of the range of activities on offer. Its seven thatched cottages are comfortable and nicely decorated, close to the swimming pool and with views over the Zambezi and the private lake.

## Day 5

This morning you will fly to Kafue National Park to stay at Kaingu for the next 4 nights.

The Kafue is the third largest national park in Africa covering 23,000 square km. It is only a 2 hour flight from Victoria Falls but is a blissfully quiet and undiscovered wilderness area totally off the tourist trail. Kafue has an enormous variety of central African mammal and bird species, many of which are not commonly seen further south including defassa waterbuck, Liechtenstein's hartebeest, roan antelope and wattled crane. The Busanga Plains are renowned for herds of hundreds of red lechwe attracting large numbers of lion and cheetah and the central riverine areas with beautiful mature trees are home to elephant, leopard, kudu, puku, wild dog and hyena. It is an excellent area for walking and the birding is exceptional.

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Kaingu Safari Lodge is a relaxing, comfortable and intimate place of paradise. There are four Meru style tents each with their own en-suite bathroom, indoor and outdoor shower or bath and private viewing deck and also a two bedroomed family house. The lodge itself has a large lounge and dining area, bar and redwood deck nestled under the forest canopy overlooking the river. It is a relaxing setting from which you can enjoy sundowners and dinner by the fire or simply relax and take in the views during the day.

### **Day 9**

Today you fly to the Lower Zambezi National Park, where you will be met and transferred to stay at Kasaka River Lodge for the next 4 nights.

The Lower Zambezi National Park is on the north bank of the Zambezi River, below Lake Kariba, and is one of the continent's most picturesque wilderness areas. It is an area of immense natural beauty with numerous different landscapes and lovely mature trees largely undamaged by elephant. The waters of the Zambezi are fringed with rich and varied vegetation, ranging from acacia woodland to flood plains, and an abundance of wildlife and birds live in the various ecosystems here.



Kasaka River Lodge is a relaxed luxury tented camp on the banks of the Zambezi River. There are 10 luxury tents spaced among the native flora and enjoying gorgeous river views. On one side, the 'wild' side, tents are reached by swing bridges and the other tents are set in the garden by the pool. There is a more secluded honeymoon tent, and Hippo Pod, set away from the main camp, for families. You frequently have close sightings of buffalo, elephant and hippo from the decks and the birdlife is abundant around the lodge: around 375 species of bird have been recorded in the vicinity.
